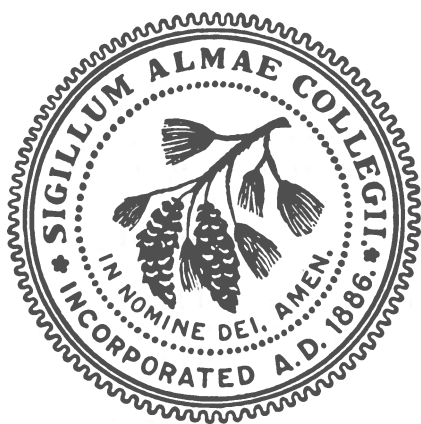

\*Fortress was composed in the winter of 1988 while Dr. Ticheli was Visiting Professor of Music at Alma College. The work was premiered by the Batawagama Youth Band on June 25 and is published by Manhattan Beach Music. Dr. Ticheli is currently Assistant Professor of Music at Trinity University in San Antonio, Texas.

\*\*Chester is based on the popular American Revolutionary hymn tune by William Billings which first appeared in The Singing Master's Assistant in 1778. First verse text is:

Let tyrants shake their iron rod,  
 And Slav'ry clank her galling chains,  
 We fear them not, We trust in God,  
 New England's God forever reigns.

\*\*\*Intrada is based on the hymn tune Lobe den Herren, which first appeared in the Stralsund Gesangbuch in 1665.

All of tonight's music was written by American composers and are original compositions for the wind band medium, with the exception of "Louvre" which was re-scored for band by the composer.
